

## **OBITUARY FOR LATE APOSTLE (ir) NOAH KANDISHA**

Apostle Noah Kandisha was called home by our heavenly Father on Saturday, 26th October 2019 around 21:30 hours in Chipata.



Apostle Noah Kandisha was born on 10th September

1944 in Chibiya Village in Chongwe district of Lusaka Province of Zambia. He became acquainted with the New Apostolic Church at an early age of 9 through his elder brother got testified to by a brother-in-law. He was baptized in 1953 and was sealed with the gift of the holy spirit a year later in 1954.

In 1968, arrangements were made for young Noah Kandisha and four other young brothers to serve as youth leaders and Sunday school teachers and that marked the beginning of Sunday school work in most parts of Zambia.

On 5th February 1972 he got married to Jessie Joyce Mikaya Kandisha, a faithful sister who has always stood by her husband's side. Their marriage was blessed with 9 children, 7 girls and 2 boys.
